**STATEMENT OF CLAIM**

1. The Plaintiff is a Senior Police Officer and a citizen of Ghana.
2. The Defendant is a Security Analyst and a citizen of Ghana.
3. The Plaintiff states that on the 31st of December 2024, the Defendant in an interview with Peace FM evening news, alleged that the Plaintiff was directed by the Deputy IGP, Mr. Christian Tetteh Yohuno, to recruit some police officers to rig the 7th December Elections 2024 in favor of the then-ruling New Patriotic Party (NPP).
4. The Plaintiff claims that in the same interview, the Defendant indicated that the Plaintiff was the one who beat DSP Nanka Bruce, RTD. The Plaintiff asserts that the statement is not only false but also capable of putting his life in danger, as the statement could incite people against him.
5. The Plaintiff states that DSP Nanka Bruce, RTD, is still alive. It is the contention of the Plaintiff that he has never pushed him, let alone beaten him. At trial, the Defendant will be put to strict proof.
6. The Plaintiff further states that on January 6, 2025, during a Good Morning Ghana segment, the Defendant alleged that the Plaintiff killed his nephew in Wa and that the Plaintiff used some criminal police officers in uniform to kill his nephew at the time the Plaintiff was the Upper West Regional Anti-Armed Robbery Unit Commander.
7. The Plaintiff further states that the Defendant claimed he was supposed to be prosecuted, but that the Attorney General (AG) sat on the case. At trial, the Defendant will be put to strict proof of this allegation.
8. The Plaintiff further avers that many other media platforms have carried the same allegations issued by the Defendant. Again, many family members and friends have continuously drawn his attention to the false statements made against him by the Defendant, to the extent that it is creating suspicion, unease, fear, and panic among the Plaintiff's family and friends.

9. The Plaintiff avers that on one occasion, it almost caused confusion between him and his wife, as her friends have been asking whether he is actually responsible for the accusations.
10. The Plaintiff avers that the matter escalated when his father and brothers-in-law became increasingly worried and invited him to a family meeting to ascertain the veracity of the alleged statements.
11. The Plaintiff firmly contends that from the posturing of the Defendant, it is obvious that he is hell-bent on destroying the Plaintiff's reputation and causing embarrassment and public anger against him.

Wherefore, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendant as follows:

1. Damages in the sum of GHC 5,000,000.00
2. A perpetual injunction restraining the Defendant from further making such defamatory statements against the Plaintiff
3. A public retraction of the defamatory statements
4. Costs
5. Any other relief(s) deemed just and/or fit by the Honourable Court.
