**Clarification on Strategic Mobilisation Ghana Ltd's (SML)  
Claims Regarding Expanded Mandate**

The Ghana Revenue Authority (GRA) has noted with concern reports published on 14th May 2025 in online news portals and print media, including Business and Financial Times and Graphic Online, claiming that Strategic Mobilisation Ghana Ltd. (SML) has unveiled an expansion of its revenue assurance oversight to cover Ghana's upstream petroleum and solid minerals sectors.

GRA wishes to clarify that the Authority's suspension of SML's services in the upstream petroleum and mineral sectors pending further review issued in April 2024, remains in force.

GRA has not instructed SML to activate nor resume operations under the 2023 Consolidation of Revenue Assurance Services Contract covering those sectors.

The Authority wishes to assure stakeholders in the aforementioned sectors and the general public of its unwavering commitment to protect the nation's revenue with integrity and transparency.
